Report of PRN Committee
Meeting

Jill Howell, Chair, presented a report of the meeting of the Advisory Committee of the Program for Recovering Nurses held on July 11, 2008. Board members reviewed the significant activities for the past quarter and reviewed the recommendations and requests from Committee members. That:

1. disciplinary action be taken against the license held by Heide G - Case EN070601
2. a policy be developed for a licensee who previously completed the program as a non-board referral and seeks to re-enter the program must then enroll as a board referral. The policy would be effective if there has been a violation of the NPA, even if a formal complaint has not been received.
3. the Board consider Strategies to address the concern that inability to afford costs of being in the program is a primary reason that participants are unsuccessful.

Judy Nagel presented information on educational accreditation and approval. Following a discussion on educational philosophy, a subcommittee was appointed to assist with developing a philosophy of education for Board review. Committee members are: Susan Odom, Janine Baxter, and Judy Nagel, Staff member.

Clinical Connections

Dessa Lagerstrom, PhD, RN, Supervisor for Student Services, St. Lukes, met with the Board as a representative of Clinical Connections, a coalition of nursing schools and agencies that meet to negotiate clinical nursing placements and enhance clinical nursing education in the Treasure Valley.

Dr. Lagerstrom discussed the difficulty in finding clinical placements for all of the nursing students in the Treasure Valley. Facilities have students in clinical seven (7) days a week and at least 18 hours a day. Facilities are working with Clinical Connections to provide learning opportunities but feel that there is little room to increase the numbers of clinical spaces for nursing students.

Dr. SeAnne Safaii, Chair of Health Professions Program, Cathleen Currie, incoming Health Professions Program Manager, Selland College, Dr. Pam Springer, Associate Dean, College of Health Sciences and Chair of the nursing department, and George Frisbee, Program Head of the

AAS program, Boise State University, met with the Board to discuss the transfer of the AS program to the Larry Selland College of Applied Technology, and the request to change the Associate of Science degree to an Associate of Applied Science degree. Enrollment is expected to begin in Fall 2009. Following the discussion, action was taken to accept the proposed changes to the Boise State University curriculum.



SCOT ASKHAM – N-34479 – Contested Case (Default Hearing)

On April 1, 2008, the Executive Director of the Idaho Board of Nursing filed and served an administrative Complaint against Scot. The Affidavit of Janet Edmonds establishes that service of the Complaint was accomplished by certified and regular mail to Scot at the Federal Correctional Institution in Anthony, Texas, where he is incarcerated. The Complaint notified Scot of his procedural rights to contest the allegations in the Complaint, including his right to a hearing before the Board. The Complaint further notified Scot of his obligation to file an Answer to the Complaint and to expressly request a hearing and that failure to do either would constitute a default and waiver of the right to hearing. Scot has not filed an Answer or otherwise responded to the Complaint. On June 25, 2008, the Executive Director filed and served a Notice of Intent to Take Default at the Board's July 24, 2008 meeting.

Charges/Violations:

The charge pending before the Board is that Scot was convicted in United States District Court for the Eastern District of Washington, Case No. CR-06-0082, of one count of Distribution of Child Pornography, a felony, and that the Court sentenced Scot to seven years incarceration as a result of the conviction. A copy of the Court's Judgment of Conviction is attached as "Exhibit A" to the Complaint. Conviction of a felony is grounds for discipline of a license pursuant to Idaho Code §54-1413(1)(c) and IDAPA 23.01.01.100.02. Although Scot apparently failed to renew his nursing license and the license expired by operation of law on August 31, 2007, Board staff requests an order of the Board revoking or indefinitely suspending the license and restricting or prohibiting Scot's future rights to reinstate his nursing license.

Failure of Scot to file a written response to allegations in the Complaint constitutes a default and the charge is deemed admitted. The admission constitutes sufficient grounds for further disciplinary action including placing reasonable restrictions on Scot's rights to reinstatement or re-licensure. The Board's enforcement attorney has presented formal Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Final Order for the Board's consideration.

Questions the Board Should Ask Itself:

- Given the default, the only relevant questions the Board needs to ask are:
1. Is discipline appropriate for the admitted felony conviction?
 2. If so, should the license be revoked or indefinitely suspended?
 3. What restrictions and conditions should the Board impose on Scot's ability to apply for reinstatement or re-licensure?

TALI EMERSON –N-24206 – Review of Order of Summary Suspension (Meeting)

In January 2004, RN Tali Emerson voluntarily surrendered her license and entered the Program for Recovering Nurses (PRN), because of drug abuse. In April 2004, the Board issued Tali a limited license while she was in the PRN. In January 2007, the limited license was terminated for failure to attend required AA/NA meetings and not turning in attendance slips on time. In March 2007, a limited license was reissued to Tali. On January 23, 2008, the Board's Executive Director issued an Order of Summary Suspension of Limited Licensure, immediately suspending Tali's limited license for:

- "Failure to maintain compliance with the terms of the Program for Recovering Nurses (PRN) Monitoring Contact signed January 20, 2004, by
- a. Failure to call in and missing a scheduled test on December 3, 2007 and again on December 27, 2007."

The members of the Program for Recovering Nurses Advisory Committee reviewed Tali's PRN file and on April 25, 2008 referred the file to the Board for disciplinary action. The Committee recommends that the Board revoke Tali's nursing license based upon non-compliance with her PRN contract. The matter has been set on the Board's agenda for a meeting with Tali on July 24, 2008 at 1:00 p.m.

The Board must determine whether to adopt the Committee's recommendation, take alternative action, or take no action.

CORRINE LUJAN –N-27198 – Review of Order of Summary Suspension (Hearing)

In December 1999, RN Corrine Lujan enrolled in the Program for Recovering Nurses (PRN). In May 2000, Corrine admitted violations of the Nursing Practice Act and voluntarily surrendered her nursing license. In September 2000, the Board issued Corrine a limited license while she was in the PRN. In October 2000, the limited license was withdrawn because the Board had received notice that Corrine had tested positive for morphine. In February 2001, the Board entered formal Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Final Order revoking Corrine’s license when she notified the Board she no longer wished to remain in the PRN. In September 2003, the Board entered formal Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Final Order denying Corrine’s request for reinstatement of her license.

In August 2005, the Board issued Corrine a temporary license. This was followed by the issuance of a limited license in September 2005. The limited license imposed conditions for a three (3) year period (that is, until September 20, 2008). On June 27, 2008, the Board’s Executive Director issued an Order of Summary Suspension of Limited Licensure, immediately suspending Corrine’s limited license for:

- “Failure to maintain compliance with the terms of the Monitoring Contract signed August 15, 2005, by
 - a. Providing another urine sample that was too dilute to test, the third such sample during your monitoring contract period, and
 - b. Falsifying AA Cards by pre-dating attendance at meetings in October and November 2007 and March 2008.”

Corrine is represented by attorney Paul Stark. Through Mr. Stark, Corrine has asked for a hearing before the Board on the summary suspension. A hearing has been scheduled for July 24, 2008 at 1:30 p.m. The parties will be given an opportunity to present evidence and make arguments at that time.

The Board must determine whether the allegations in the Suspension Order are substantiated and if so, whether to affirm or reject the summary suspension, enter such further orders revoking, suspending, or otherwise disciplining the license or “stay any order of the executive director or may modify the terms and conditions of a limited license as deemed appropriate to regulate, monitor or supervise the practice of any licensee.” Board Rule 132.06.b and c.
